Open Show Sunday 3rd July 2011

I would like to thank the Northern Counties SBT Club for inviting me to judge there open show. A huge thanks to all the committee for all the hard work they put in to ensure the smooth running of the show and to my two ring stewards Derek and Darren who did a great job. I had a good entry of 76 dogs making 99 entries, with few absentees.

Minor puppy dog 3 entries.

1st. Stanway – Waystaff Strikes Out.

White/brindle pied dog. Showing good proportions for one so young. Nice head shape, clean throughout, strong muzzle, lovely dark eyes, good mouth. He has a lovely straight front with good width to chest, well off for bone. Level topline held well on the move, short coupled with enough bend of stifle, good shapely backend. Moved well.

2nd. Harkin – Listcall Uncle Buck in Harkline.

Black/brindle, nice head shape with good ears, nice dark eye, good width to muzzle, correct teeth. Very good pigmentation. Well boned straight front, moved well for a youngster. Just preferred the height and size of 1st.

3rd. Booker – Albermarbull White Diamond at Beestaff

Puppy dog 3 entries.

1st. Cartwright – Zakstaff Game On.

Black/brindle dog who showed his socks off, not putting a foot wrong for his handler. Very good head shape, dark eyes, very nice shape to ears with a pleasing expression, enough muzzle. Good width to front, nice and straight onto tight feet, pigmentation very good black nails. Short coupled with good topline, in fit condition moving well. His condition and ring presence went on to gain him best puppy dog and best puppy in show.

2nd. Boler – Denegar Jack.

Red dog, head shape ok would prefer little more definition though, nice ears, good mouth, straight front, level topline, bend of stifle adequate, moved quite well.

3rd. Robson – Moodystaff Just An Idea.

Junior dog. 9 entries 1 absent.

1st. Lister & Callaghan.

Dark brindle with white flash on chest, lovely shaped head, good ears, eyes could be darker, nice strength to muzzle with good mouth. Good width to chest, lovely straight front, feet ok with black nails. This dog moves very well holding a level topline, good bend of stifle with a strong backend.

2nd. Turner – Quatros Neat and Tidy.

White with red patch. Lovely head shape, good ears, dark eyes, good strong muzzle with correct mouth, very pleasing expression. Lovely front on this dog. Good topline, short coupled with strong backend. Gave his lady handler a hard time.

3rd. Gough – Waystaff Dutch Gigolo.

Maiden dog. 3 entries.

1st. Smith 7 Gibbs – Wanneville Chinese Zodiac.

Black/brindle, nice head shape, lovely dark eyes, good shaped ears which would enhance his expression if he used them, straight front with tight feet, short compact dog in lovely condition.

2nd. Gough – Waystaff Dutch Gigolo.

White dog, lovely head shape, good mouth and ears, dark eyes. Good strong straight front, very short coupled, good topline, moved well.

3rd. Bostock – Brannan's Soldier.

Novice dog. 5 entries.

1st. Cartwright – Zakstaff game On.

See first in puppy.

2nd. Gough – Waystaff Dutch Gigolo.

See second in maiden.

3rd. Lockwood – Wanneville Self Indulgence.

Graduate dog. 5 entries 1 absent.

1st. Cartwright – Zakstaff Game On.

See first in puppy.

2nd. Fairhurst – Fairleniums Snow Patrol.

Black/white pied, unplaced in strong junior class. Nice head shape, good mouth, lovely dark eye. Short powerful compact dog, nice expression.

3rd. Wilson – Bullhawk Code Master.

Post graduate dog. 2 entries 1 absent.

1st. Bostock – Brannan's Soldier.

White/brindle pied. Stood alone in this class. This dog does not fit the standard too well. Powerful dog with brindle patches on face, ears bit too high, mouth was untidy, front was too wide, weakness at the pasterns, feet need tightening. He was presented carrying too much weight in my opinion.

Limit dog. 5 entries.

1st Hart – Albermarbull Ice White.

White dog, very pleasing head shape, not overdone at all. Lovely shaped ears but needs to use them to show off his expression, great dark eyes, good strong muzzle with correct mouth. Excellent pigmentation, good width to chest, nicely boned front. Good topline held well on the move, nice shaped backend. Moved better in the challenge but did enough to win this class with ease.

2nd. Dean & Murray. – The Dark Daredevil.

Black/brindle with nice head shape, good ears, would prefer darker eye, correct mouth, moved well, in good condition. Preferred the overall balance of the winner.

3rd. Chesters – Ryestaff Jack the Lad.

Open dog. 6 entries.

1st. Davidson – Waystaff Dutch Minister JW

Brindle dog with white flash on face and chest. Lovely shaped ears, dark eyes, strong muzzle with good mouth. Very pleasing head shape with enough strength to foreface without being over done, clean throughout, excellent expression. Enough width to chest, straight front, tidy feet. Compact dog, short coupled. Very good topline held well on the move. Well muscled backend, with good bend of stifle. Moved well for the handler. Fits the standard very well. Best dog and reserve best in show.

2nd. Peacock – Dringshaw Stoner.

Red dog, good head shape with excellent expression using ears well. Good mouth. Good honest front, moved very well holding a solid topline. Reserve best dog.

3rd. Smith & Gibbs. – Wanneville The Governor.

Veteran dog. 2 entries.

1st. Harkin – Ch. Harkline Robbie The Bruce JW.

Black/brindle dog 9 years old, an absolute showman, lovely head piece, neat ears, dark eye, lovely strength to muzzle. Well boned straight front, short coupled, excellent topline, good bend of stifle. In excellent condition. A real pleasure to be able to judge this dog.

2nd. Fairhurst – Yorks One More Time for Fairlenium.

Black/brindle with white, lovely expression, used ears well, nice straight, moved very well. Condition a credit to his owners.

Minor puppy bitch 4 entries.

1st. Bryan – Valglo Lucia.

Dark brindle girl, seven and a half months old, a real baby but already everything in all the right places. Very pretty head shape, strong yet feminine. Lovely dark eye, neat ears, strong muzzle, straight front, well off for bone, short coupled, good topline. Best puppy bitch. Just missed out for best pup in show as the dog showed himself off so well.

2nd. Hart – Albermarbull Fire 'n' Ice.

White with red patches. Pleasant head shape, nice ears, good dark eyes, correct mouth. Lovely straight front, nice tidy feet, decent topline, nice bend of stifle, moved well. Just preferred the compactness of the winner. Still a very nice puppy.

3rd. Miller – Albermarbull Black Ice at Skyland.

Puppy bitch 5 entries 2 absent.

1st. Woollett – Manark Temptress.

Black/brindle girl, lovely head shape, dark eyes, ears could be tidier though. Correct mouth, good strength to muzzle, good solid front although the handle tends to stand her too wide. Compact little bitch, decent topline, moved well.

2nd. Alger – Crossguns Bit Ova Peach.

Black.brindle, feminine girl, nice ears, correct mouth, straight front, tight feet, good pigmentation, moved ok.

3rd. Dean & Murray - Cannichbull Delves Delight.

Junior bitch 6 entries.

1st. Hirst & Bibby – Tariel Ciara.

Absolute beauty, black brindle, super strong but feminine head, beautiful rose shaped ears, dark eyes that melt you. Correct mouth, a very keen expression, muzzle strong, enough definition to head. Straight well boned front, correct width to chest. Strong level topline, short coupled, correct tailset, good bend

to stifles, stood four square, feet lovely and tight, nails black. Never put a foot wrong, moved with purpose and drive, looked great from every angle, put done in super condition. A real credit to the owners. Best bitch and best in show.

2nd. Summerfield – Canakey Sweet Pea.

A red girl that is strong yet feminine, lovely dark mask, neat ears, dark eyes. Good strength to muzzle, correct mouth, well boned front onto tidy feet. Short coupled bitch with very good topline. Strong backend, she has a lovely expression, again condition a credit to her owner.

3rd. Robinson – Sabahouse Lets Hope for Boydclass.

Maiden bitch 4 entries.

1st. Woollett – Manark Temptress.

See first in puppy.

2nd. Nicholson – Absolstaff Classic Act at Ballindona.

Black/brindle with feminine head shape, nice ears, eyes ok. Nice straight front, tight feet, good topline strong backend, moved well.

3rd. Miller – Albermarbull Black Ice at Skyland.

Novice bitch 3 entries 1 absent.

1st. Woollett – Manark Temptress.

See first in puppy.

2nd. Bedford – Freoa Firestorm at Smokemount.

Topsized brindle girl, feminine head shape, good straight front on her, level topline, moved quite well.

Graduate bitch 8 entries 1 absent.

1st. Hirst & Bibby – Taniel Ciara.

See first in junior.

2nd. Robinson – Sabahouse Lets Hope For Boydslass.

Black/brindle bitch placed third in a strong junior class. Nice feminine head shape, ears ok, dark eyes, correct mouth, lovely straight front with tight feet and black nails. Good topline held on the move, good bend of stifle. In first class condition. Moved very well.

3rd. Draper – Herodotus Well Lush.

Post graduate bitch 6 entries 2 absent.

1st. Hart – Albermarbull Sweet Pea.

White with red patches, lovely shaped head, very neat ears, dark eyes, good width to muzzle, correct bite. Well boned straight front, level topline, sound backend. Moved well, very good pigmentation.

2nd. Robinson – Boydslass Bevin Belle.

Black Brindle, quite feminine head shape, would prefer a little more strength in muzzle. Dark eyes, neat ears, straight front, in good condition moved ok. Just liked the overall substance of the winner.

3rd. Draper – Herodotus Well Lush.

Limit bitch 9 entries 4 absent.

1st. Leadbitter & Wandless.

Mahogany brindle who has a lovely expression, neat ears, dark eyes, good mouth. Straight front, tidy feet. Short coupled with good topline, moves very well but could have been fitter.

2nd. Turner – Trawden Snowball at Quatros.

White with red patch. Very pleasing head shape, lovely dark eyes, neat ears, nice strength to muzzle, good mouth. Straight front. Moved well for her lady handler. Nothing to separate these two girls could change places an another day.

3rd. Nicholson – Ballindona Bombshell.

Open bitch 9 entries 3 absent.

1st. Robinson – Craigails Indian Summer.

Good strong yet feminine black/brindle. Very similar to the junior winner but more of this girl. Lovely head shape with very neat ears which she used well, dark eyes, good strength to muzzle with correct mouth. Lovely definition to her head. Well boned straight front with ample width to chest, neat and tidy feet with black nails. Strong top line held well on the move, powerful backend, good bent of stifle. In excellent condition. Moved with purpose. Reserve best bitch.

2nd. Johnson – Tillcarr Black Betty.

Black/brindle with white on chest. Good head shape with neat ears, lovely expression, nice strength to muzzle, correct mouth. Straight front, good topline, strong backend. Moved very well.

3rd. Stanway – Waystaff Dutch Pearl.

Veteran bitch 2 entries.

1st. Johnson – CH. Tillcarr Ring Of Fire ShCM

Seven year old black/brindle, cannot believe this girl is a veteran already. Lovely head shape, dark eyes, good ears, shows her expression well. Her front is straight leading onto tidy feet. Topline is level, good powerful backend, moved effortlessly. Showed and handled well.

2nd. Robinson – Causing Commotion.

Nearly eight years old, this brindle girl seemed to enjoy herself. Lovely expression. Tidy ears, decent muzzle, lovely straight front, she also moved very well, in good condition.
